### CLINICAL REQUIREMENTS & IMMUNIZATION CHECKLIST

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- CPR – Provide a current American Heart Association Healthcare Provider BLS - Adult, Child & Infant CPR Certification with AED training. (Jefferson College Continuing Education - 636-481-3144)
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap within last 10 years) – One Tdap vaccination required.
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) – Documentation of two doses of varicella vaccine at least four weeks apart **OR** titer showing immunity **OR** history of varicella based on physician diagnosis.
- Hepatitis B Series – Hep B series must be started prior to first clinical. This series will take six months to complete.
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) – Documentation of two doses of MMR vaccine at least four weeks apart **OR** titer showing immunity to Measles, Mumps, and Rubella.
- Two-Step PPD on Admission; Annual One-Step PPD required annually thereafter (or Chest X-Ray if PPD is positive). The two-step PPD takes a total of four visits. Give yourself plenty of time to complete this. See the following explanation of a two-step PPD.

**Example of Two-Step PPD** (Requires PPD administered and read twice):

- PPD #1 administered on June 2
- PPD #1 read on June 4

The second PPD *must be completed 7 days after the first PPD, and no more than 21 days after the first PPD.*

- PPD #2 administered on June 16
- PPD #2 read on June 18

- Annual Flu Vaccination – Documentation of flu shot administered during the current flu season.

**NOTE:**

- Please advise the Clinical Coordinator or Program Director of any applicable medical exemption(s) to any of the above listed vaccinations.
- Bring completed *History/Physical Examination* form and *proof of immunizations/clinical requirements* to the New Student Orientation.
