

ALL JCLEA PROGRAM CLASS TIMES

Day class –

Meets Monday - Friday, 8:30 am - 3:30 pm.

This course begins in August and ends in May of the following year [consists of two college semesters].

Applications due by June 15.

Night class –

Meets Monday – Thursday, 6:00 pm 10:00 p.m. and two 8-hour Saturdays per month.

This course begins in January and ends in December each year [consists of three college semesters].

Applications due by November 1.

P.O.S.T. only class–

Meets Monday – Thursday, 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and two 8-hour Saturdays per month.

This course begins in October and ends in July of the following year [an eight-month timeframe].

Applications due by August 15.

Law Enforcement Academy

A Missouri P.O.S.T. Certified Training Academy



Jefferson College Law Enforcement Academy is the *only* academy in the state of Missouri that offers the P.O.S.T. certified training *and* Associate of Applied Science Degree in Criminal Justice in the same program

Jefferson College Law Enforcement Academy (JCLEA) offers three options for students pursuing a career in law enforcement.

For students *without* prior significant college credits (60+) the DAY and NIGHT programs are the best option.

JCLEA is the only academy in the state of Missouri that incorporates an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Criminal Justice and the training required for P.O.S.T. Class A licensing in the DAY and NIGHT programs.

The newest addition to the academy programs is the P.O.S.T. Only program. This program is for students who have already earned a 2-year, 4-year, or more degree from a regionally accredited college/university, or have completed the general education prerequisites. The successful completion of the P.O.S.T. Only program, earns the student a Class A license to be a police officer in the state of Missouri.



The JCLEA DAY and NIGHT classes include P.O.S.T. and general education topics as they apply to the law enforcement field and the Associate of Applied Science Degree in Criminal Justice.

Specialized certifications are included in all three programs:

- ◆ Firearms
- ◆ OC Pepper Spray
- ◆ Expandable Baton
- ◆ First Responder
- ◆ RADAR/LIDAR operations
- ◆ Datamaster Breath Alcohol Analyzer Type III Operator
- ◆ Standard Field Sobriety Testing

Academy training also includes hands-on activities such as: Defensive Tactics, Driver Simulator, First Aid and practical training and scenarios
